Allman and Mattis Dominate the Discus at Triton Invitational

Friday, April 7th – Saturday, April 8th; La Jolla, CA – At last weekend's <u>Triton Invitational in California</u>, Olympic champion Valarie Allman dominated the invitational women's discus throw with a throw of 70.25m/230-5, a mark that was more than three meters better than Jorinde Van Klinken's second placed 67.05m/219-11. Third place went to Yaime Perez Tellez with a throw of 66.97m/219-8. The men's invitational discus also came to the NYAC, with Sam Mattis reaching 67.49m/221-5, comfortably ahead of Alex Rose of Garage Strength, whose best attempt reached 65.69m/215-6. Nicholas Percy of Great Britain took third with 63.54m/208-5. Click here for full results from La Jolla. • Friday, April 7th – Saturday, April 8th; Oxford, MS – The NYAC's Janeah Stewart placed second in the women's hammer throw at the <u>Joe Walker Invitational</u>, launching the implement to 70.53m/231-4. Erin Reese of Velaasa took the event with a winning 73.47m/241-00, while Jasmine Mitchell of Old Miss was third with a personal best of 66.63m/218-07.
