

NYAC Track and Field Claims Four National Titles

Thursday, February 16th - Saturday, February 18th; Albuquerque, NM - At the USATF Indoor Championships this past weekend, NYAC track and field athletes secured a remarkable seven medals, including four gold medals. Miranda Melville (3000m Race Walk), DeAnna Price (Weight Throw), Daniel Haugh (Weight Throw), and Joe Kovacs (Shot Put) each won their respective events. Notably, DeAnna recorded a world record of 26.02m/85-4 1/2 on her fifth throw. The previous world record of 25.60m /84-0 was recorded by Gwen Berry in 2017. Brooke Andersen (Weight Throw) secured a silver medal, and Emmanuel Corvera (3000m Race Walk) and Rudy Winkler (Weight Throw) each secured bronze medals in their events. Janeah Stewart (Weight Throw) and

Brycen Spratling (400m) finished sixth and fifth in their respective events. In the women's weight throw, 2019 world hammer throw champion **DeAnna Price** secured the win with a mark of 26.02m/85-04 1/2 on her fifth throw. Brooke Andersen took second with 24.97m/81-11 1/4, and Rachel Tanczos of Velaasa took third with 24.58m/80-07 3/4. 2015 and 2019 world shot put champion **Joe Kovacs** secured the shot put win with a mark of 21.55m/70-08 1/2 on his sixth and final throw, Jordan Geist of Arizona took second with 21.36m/70-01.00, and Adrian Piperi (unattached) took third in 21.05m/69-00 3/4. Rio 2016 Olympian **Miranda Melville** broke the tape of the 3000m race walk in 13:37.69, Maria Michta-Coffey of Oiselle took second in 13:49.29, and Janelle Branch of

Tracksmith took third in 14:04.17. In the men's weight throw, Tokyo 2020 Olympian **Daniel Haugh** won with a mark of 25.44m/83-05 3/4, which he achieved on his third throw of the competition. Alex Young (unattached) took second with 24.25m/79-06 3/4, and the NYAC's Rudy Winkler took third with 23.88m/78-04 1/4. Click here for complete results from USATF Indoors.
