NYAC Rowers Dominate at USRowing Winter Speed Order



Friday, March 3rd – Sunday, March 5th; Sarasota, FL – At the USRowing Winter Speed Order this past weekend, the NYAC nearly swept the women's pair, securing first through fifth places. Tokyo 2020 Olympian Charlotte Buck (NYAC) and teammate Jessica Thoennes won the event in 7:06.59. Kelsey Reelick (NYAC) and Molly Bruggeman took second in 7:08.11, Claire Collins (NYAC) and Teal Cohen took third in 7:08.84, Meghan Musnicki (NYAC) and Alie Rusher were fourth in 7:09.32, and Alina Hagstrom (NYAC) and Regina Salmons were fifth in 7:11.92. Other top NYAC finishes of the weekend included Nick Mead's (NYAC) second place finish in the men's pair with a mark of 6:26.71 with teammate Justin Best, and Sam Melvin's third place finish in the lightweight men's single with a

time of 7:00.23. The NYAC's **James Francis** finished sixth in that event in 7:21.05. In the men's single, the NYAC's **Eliot Putnam** and Greg Davis took sixth and ninth, respectively, and in the lightweight women's single, **Riona McCormick** placed 10th. **Click here** for full results from Sarasota.
