As the July 23rd Olympic Games Opening Ceremony draws ever nearer, more winged foot athletes are booking their tickets. The latest Club member to be adding to the Team USA roster is triathlete Katie Zaferes. She joins her teammates Taylor Knibb, Summer Rappaport and Morgan Pearson, meaning that the NYAC has filled four of the five Olympic spots for which the US has qualified. Will Claye (TJ), DeAnna Price (HT), Katie Nageotte (PV) and Joe Kovacs (SP) are among the many NYAC athletes with powerful chances of making the team and going all the way in Tokyo. ## Water Polo

From June 14th to 19th, the US women are playing in the FINA World League Super Final in Athens, Greece, the team's last international competition before the Olympics. Let's just say that the signs are looking good. Results so far: June 14th - US vs. Greece (16-9, US); June 15th - US vs. Kazakhstan (20-2, US); June 16th - US vs. Spain (18-9, US). As of Wednesday at 4pm, the US led Group B with nine points. In today's quarter-final, the US remained unbeaten, defeating Japan 20-6. Semi-finals take place tomorrow, Friday, 18th, with the final on Saturday. Follow all the updates here.

## Modern Pentathlon

At the UIPM 2021 Pentathlon and Laser Run World Championships, in Cairo from June 8th-14th, Tokyo-bound Samantha Schultz placed 25th in the individual women's competition, contributing to a 10th place US team finish. In the women's and men's relays, Schultz and Amro Elgeziry combined with non-NYAC members to place 10th and eighth, respectively, powerful results in deep competitive fields. Results are here.
