Rowing - Results from the Trials

On Friday, March 25th, at the <u>Senior Trials I</u> in Sarasota, FL, the NYAC's **Sam Melvin** placed third in the Final A of the men's lightweight single sculls speed order, with a time of 7:17.69. Zachary Hesse of Texas Center took the gold medal with a finishing time of 7:07.48. On the women's side, the NYAC's **Alex Morss** placed second in the B Final of the lightweight single sculls speed order with a finishing time of 8:33.11. For many boats, the senior trials count towards selection for the US team for this year's world championships, though not for the lightweight sculls events in which Melvin and Morss competed.

Track and Field - DeAnna Price on the Comeback Trail

The NYAC's **DeAnna Price** was a favorite to take the Olympic gold medal in Tokyo last year. A severe ankle injury dashed her hopes, however; she ultimately placed eighth, throwing on a broken ankle. Seven months ago, Price underwent a total ankle reconstruction, followed by a complete labrum repair six months ago. Now, and with a US-based world championships taking place in July, Price has started on the road back to the pinnacle of here sport. On Friday, March 25th at the Margaret Simmons Invitational Track and Field Meet at Murray State University in Murray, KY, DeAnna threw the hammer 72.39m/237-6.
