Judo - Throw Down in Tel Aviv

NYAC judokas **Hannah Martin** (-63kg) and **Nicolas Yonezuka** (-81kg) went 1-1 this past weekend at the Tel Aviv Grand Slam, in Tel Aviv, Israel from Thursday, February 17th to Saturday, February 19th. Track and Field - USATF Indoor Championships This Weekend

This weekend, from Saturday, February 26th to Sunday, February 27th, the NYAC's track and field athletes will have a chance to claim national titles at the 2022 USATF Indoor Championships at "The Podium" in Spokane, WA. On the track, **Brycen Spratling** will race the 400m, and **Devon Williams**, the 60m hurdles. On the field, **Will Claye** and **Tori Franklin** will triple jump, and **Rudy Winkler** will throw the weight. On the track *and* on the field, **Erica Bougard** will contest the five-event pentathlon. At the most recent installment of this meet, which was held in February of 2020 in Albuquerque, NM, Tori Franklin won the triple jump in 14.64m/48-0.5, defeating Keturah Orgi by 0.04m. Spratling placed fourth in the 400m, running 46.50 in the final. The 2022 USATF Indoor Championships will serve as USATF's qualifying meet for the World Indoor Championships, which will take place in Belgrade, Serbia from March 11th-13th.
