

# Happy 100th to Herb Douglas



Olympic bronze medalist and NYAC Hall of Famer, **Herb Douglas**, celebrated his 100th birthday on Wednesday, March 9th. The oldest living American Olympic medalist, Herb secured his medal in the long jump at the 1948 Olympic Games in London. These days a resident of Philadelphia, he returned to his hometown of Pittsburgh, PA to celebrate the big day, with his 98-year-old wife, Minerva, by his side. In addition to his track and field accolades, Herb was an accomplished football player while studying at the University of Pittsburgh. He was also, for many years, the driving force behind the Jesse Owens Award, these days housed in the NYAC's Hall of Fame. Herb and the leger

### Fencing - Holmes and Cebula Excel in Budapest

On Saturday, March 5th in Budapest, Hungary, NYAC fencers **Kat Holmes** and **Anne Cebula** placed sixth and seventh, respectively, each with 21 points, in the senior epée competition at the Westend Grand Prix this past. Two hundred and ten fencers from around the world took to the piste in this competition. The NYAC women's results mark the first time that two USA fencers have finished in the top eight of a World Cup tournament.
