Track and Field - Claye Fourth, Franklin 13th at World Indoor Championships

On Friday, March 18th, the NYAC's Will Claye finished fourth in the men's triple jump at the World Indoor Championships held in Belgrade, Serbia,



reaching a mark of 17.19m/56-4.75, which he achieved on his fifth attempt. Lazaro Martinez of Cuba won with a world-leading mark of 17.64m/57-10.5. The women's triple jump took place on Sunday, March 20th, with the NYAC's **Tori Franklin** placing 13th with a mark of 13.89m/45-7, which she achieved on her first attempt. On Tuesday, the NYAC's **Sam Melvin** and **Alex Morss** contested the men's and women's time trials of the lightweight single sculls speed orders. Melvin placed fourth, with a finish of 6:58.78, and Morrs placed ninth, recording a time of 8:05.17. 


Team Handball - NYAC Men at West Point
