On Friday, November 5th, five NYAC triathletes excelled at the 2021 World Triathlon Championships Series Abu Dhabi. **Vincent Luis** placed second in the men's race, while **Morgan Pearson** placed 24th. Among the women, **Taylor Knibb** placed fifth, **Taylor Spivey** placed 11th and **Summer Rappaport** finished 17th.
