# Track and Field - McFadden Wins in Chicago, Second in Boston

October 14th, 2021

Tatyana McFadden brought her tally of major marathon victories to 24 on Sunday, October 10th, after winning the Chicago Marathon with a finishing time of 1:48:57. For full results of the race, click here. One plane ride and less than 24 hours later, Tatyana secured a silver medal at the Boston Mara-

thon with a finishing time of 1:50:20, defeated by Manuela Schar of Switzerland, who crossed the line in 1:35:21. For Boston results, **click here**. ## Soccer - NYAC Winning Streak Continues


On Sunday, October 10th, the NYAC men's soccer team made it four in a row, defeating Polonia SC 2-1 at McCarren Park in Greenpoint, Brooklyn. In fact, the NYAC scored all three goals, the first being an own goal in the early minutes. The winged foot team quickly turned it around with a beautifully taken free kick from 20 yards out, a swerving left-footer that tied the contest. The match then turned into a battle until, with about 10 minutes remaining, a header sealed the deal. In the reserves' match, the NYAC ran away 5-0 winners. The squads are home at Travers Island this coming weekend in the opening round of the State Cup. Reserves vs. Williamsburg International kicks off at 10am; Firsts vs. New Amsterdam II starts at 12pm.
