Triathlon - The Season Continues

On Saturday, September 18th, **Summer Rappaport** finished third at the Hamburg Wasser World Triathlon in Hamburg, Germany, completing the race in 58:26, with the fastest swim in the women's field. **Kirsten Kasper** placed seventh in 58:41. The following day, Summer, along with her Team USA teammates, placed fifth in the mixed relay in a time of 1:22:51. For results, **click here**. NYAC triathletes **Ben Kanute** and **Taylor Knibb** finished sixth (3:43:48) and third (4:08:50), respectively, in the Ironman 70.3 World Championships in St. George, Utah on Saturday, October 18th.
