Track and Field - More Medals for McFadden

Twenty-time Paralympic medalist **Tatyana McFadden** captured the silver medal at the Berlin Marathon on Sunday, September 26th. She finished in 1:38:54, one minute and 23 seconds behind winner, Manuela Schar of Switzerland. The race report is here. At the Elk Run 5K in Crested Butte, CO on Saturday, September 25th, Olympic triathlon silver medalist, **Morgan Pearson**, placed fourth in 15:03.5. **Will Leer**, NYAC runner and husband of Tokyo 2020 Olympian Aisha-Praught Leer, finished 10th in 16:08.6. From October 2nd to 10th, the NYAC's top wrestlers, including Olympic medalists Adeline Gray and Sarah Hildebrandt, will be challenging for medals at the World Wrestling Championships, taking place is Oslo, Norway. Triathlon - Taking on the Eliminator

Eliminator triathlons consist of three rounds each of swimming (300m), bik-

ing (3.6K) and running (1.6K). A pre-determined number of back-markers is eliminated after each discipline of every stage. At the 2021 Eliminator Malibu on Saturday, September 25th, the final race of the 2021 Super League Triathlon Series, **Katie Zaferes** claimed the bronze medal in the women's race in a time of 48:59 with **Taylor Spivey** eighth in 49:43. **Vincent Luis** (FRA) finished sixth amlong the men in a time of 45:16. In the season-end final standings, Zaferes finished third (49 points), Spivey was sixth (37
