



Swimming - Three Events for DeLoof at Phillips 66 National Championships



Tuesday, July 26th–Saturday, July 30th; Irvine, CA – The NYAC's Olympic bronze medalist, **Catie DeLoof**, and **Zach Fong** competed in several events at the Phillips 66 National Championships, achieving excellent results. DeLoof finished third in the B Final of the 100m freestyle with a time of 54.84 on July 26th; Amy Fulmer of Ohio State won in 54.57. In the 100m backstroke on July 29th, the NYAC woman finished 15th with a time of 1:01.61; Isabelle Stadden of UC Berkeley won in 59.63. On July 30th, DeLoof placed fifth in the heats of the 50m freestyle with a finish of 25.05 but did not advance to the final. Fong finished 50th in the heats of the

Track and Field - Gold For Kovacs at Ed Murphey Classic

Friday, July 29th-Saturday, July 30th; Memphis, TN – In his first competition since claiming the silver medal at the 2022 World Championships in Eugene, OR, **Joe Kovacs**, dominated the shot put at the Ed Murphey Classic in Memphis, taking the win with a meet record of 21.88m/71-9.5. Fellow Americans Adrian Piperi and Darrell Hill took second and third with throws of 21.37m/70-1.5 and 21.32m/69-11.5, respectively. As an aside, Kovacs and his wife, Ashley, are expecting twins in November 2022. The NYAC's **Mikey Brannigan**, Rio 2016 1500m Paralympic champion, finished 17th in the 1500m with a time of 3:58:03.
