Track & Field - NYAC Takes Three World Champs Medals

Friday, July 15th – Sunday, July 24th; Eugene, OR – The 2022 World Athletics Championships kicked off in Eugene, OR last Friday with eight NYAC athletes competing: Valarie Allman (discus), Joe Kovacs (shot put), Tori Franklin (triple jump), Rudy Winkler (hammer throw), Sam Mattis (discus), Miranda Melville (20K and 35K race walks), Kara Winger (javelin) and Will Claye (triple jump). As of Thursday (July 21st) NYAC athletes had secured three medals: Joe Kovacs claimed the shot put silver medal, with a throw of 22.89m/75-1.25, on Sunday, July 17th; Tori Franklin took the triple jump bronze medal, with a jump of 14.72m/48-3.5, on Monday, July 19th; and Valarie Allman secured the discus bronze medal, with a throw of 68.30m, on Wednesday, July 20th. Rudy Winkler finished sixth in the hammer throw on Saturday, July 16th, with a throw of 78.99m/259-2, Sam Mattis finished 11th in the discus on Tuesday, July 19th, with a throw of 63.19m, and Miranda Melville finished 35th in the 20K race walk on Friday, July 15th, with a time of 1:39:58. NYAC finals yet to come include Miranda Melville in the 35K race walk and Kara Winger in the javelin, both today, Friday, 22nd. Will Claye contested the triple jump qualification round yesterday, Thursday, July 21st, advancing to Saturday's final by virtue of a third round jump of 16.70m/54-9.5. Fencing - Holmes Fifth at World Championships

Friday, July 15th-Saturday, July 23rd; Cairo, Egypt – The NYAC's two-time Olympian (2016, 2020), Kat Holmes, finished 33rd overall in the senior women's individual epée competition at the World Fencing Championships, but teamed up with Margherita Guzzi, Anna Van Brummen and Isis Washington to take fifth in the team competition behind Korea, Italy, Poland and France. The NYAC's Justin Yoo finished 91st in the senior men's individual epée. The US men's epée team, featuring Yoo and teammates Curtis McDowald, Yeisser Ramirez and Cooper Schumacher, finished 17th.
