Rowing - NYAC Shines at Head of the Charles

Friday, October 21st – Sunday, October 23rd; Cambridge, MA – NYAC rowers had excellent performances last weekend at the historic Head of the Charles Regatta, which was first organized in 1965. In the women's championship fours, USRowing A, including the NYAC's Charlotte Buck, Kelsey Reelick, and Maddie Wanamaker, secured the victory in a finish of 16:48.415. Brown University A took second in 17:22.921 and Calgary RC A rounded out the podium in 17:25.280. The NYAC's Nick Mead, rowing with Peloton, won the men's championship four in 15:17.376. Cornell University A took second in 15:42.017, and Princeton A took third in 15:42.744. Eliot Putnam of the NYAC claimed the men's championship single bronze medal with a finish of 17:54.417, and fellow NYAC rower Sam Melvin finished 12th in 18:27.548. In the men's club four, the NYAC B boat – Connor Corwen, Veton Celaj, Paul Verni, and Matt Ptucha – took fourth in 16:54.503, and the NYAC A boat – Magdalene Baert, Edward Gonzalez, Anthony Perasso, Dillon Cumming, and Ryan Ujazdowski – finished 12th in 17:14.054. Riverfront Recapture A won in 16:38.500. In the women's youth double, the NYAC A boat – Teagan Farley and Lillian Auth – secured the silver medal with a 19:00.521 finish. Judo - Hannah Martin Seventh at Abu Dhabi Grand Slam

Friday, October 21st – Sunday, October 23rd; Abu Dhabi, UAE – 2019 Pan American -63kg bronze medalist Hannah Martin finished seventh at the Abu Dhabi Grand Slam last weekend. Hannah won her first two rounds – the first against Cristina Cabana Perez of Spain by waza ari and the second against Agatha Schmidt of Germany by ippon. In the quarterfinal, Hannah was defeated by Lucy Renshall of Great Britain by ippon, and in the repechage, she lost to Joanne Van Lieshout of the Netherlands by ippon in a quick 00:48. The NYAC's judo brothers Jack (-73kg) and Nicolas Yonezuka (-81kg) also contested their weights in Abu Dhabi but did not advance beyond their second rounds, respectively.
