Judo - World Championships Underway in Tashkent

Thursday, October 6th – Wednesday, October 12th; Tashkent, Uzbekistan – The World Judo Championships are presently underway in Tashkent, the capital city of Uzbekistan, and NYAC judokas have already taken to the tatamis in pursuit of world titles. Thus far, Katelyn Jarrell (-52kg), Angie Delgado (-52kg), and Adonis Diaz (-60kg) have contested their weights. After defeating Djamila Silva of Cape Verde by ippon in the second round, Katelyn Jarrell advanced to the third round, where she was defeated by Chelsie Giles of Great Britain by ippon. Chelsie Giles would go on to secure the -52kg world silver medal; Uta Abe of Japan won the weight. Also in the -52kg category, the NYAC's Angie Delgado was defeated in the second round by Yerin Jung of Korea by waza-ari. For videos of all of the -52kg contests, click here. In the men's -60kg division, the NYAC's Adonis Diaz was defeated by Yam Wolczak of Israel by ippon in the first round. Coming up this weekend, Dominic Rodriguez (-73kg) and Jack Yonezuka (-73kg) will compete on Saturday, October 8th, and Hannah Martin (-63kg) and Nick Yonezuka (-81kg) will compete on Sunday, October 9th. Next week, Alex Knauf will contest -90kg on Monday, October 10th, and Christian Konoval will contest +100kg on Wednesday, October 12th.
