

Track and Field - Kovacs Conquers in Lausanne

Friday, August 26th; Lausanne, Switzerland - With his second throw of the night, a mark of 22.65m/74-3.75, the NYAC's **Joe Kovacs** secured the shot put victory at the Diamond League Athletissima in Lausanne, Switzerland. In the process, he defeated the indomitable Ryan Crouser, the world and Olympic champion, who placed second with a throw of 22.05m/72-4.25. In the women's triple jump, World Championships bronze medalist, **Tori Franklin**, took fifth with a leap of 14.21m/46-7.5 behind the winning mark of 15.31m/50-2.75 by world champion, Yulimar Rojas from Venezuela. **Click here** to see Kovacs in action and **here** for complete results.

Saturday, August 27th – Sunday, August 28th; Bergen, Norway – At the World Triathlon Cup in Bergen, Norway, the NYAC's Kirsten Kasper and Matt McElroy placed 10th and 11th, respectively. Tilda Mansson of Sweden won the women's race in 1:02:48, with

This Week in NYAC Sports History - September 4th, 1920; Elmont, NY - Thoroughbred Man o' War, regarded as the greatest racehorse of all time, wins the 1 5/8-mile Lawrence Realization Stakes at Belmont Park by 100 lengths, the largest winning margin in modern thoroughbred racing history, recording a world record time of 2:30.8. That same year, Man o' War was honored alongside Babe Ruth as the New York Times Athlete of the Year. The legendary horse was bred by the NYAC's August Belmont, Jr., the financier of the original NYC subway and the son of August Belmont, for whom the Belmont Stakes and Belmont Park are named.
