## Track and Field - Valarie Allman Claims **Discus Title at Prefontaine Classic**



Friday, May 27th - Saturday, May 28th; Eugene, OR - The NYAC's Valarie Allman, Tokyo 2020 Olympic discus champion and American record-holder (71.46m/234'5"), won the women's discus with a mark of 68.35m/224'3" at the Prefontaine Classic, hosted at the University of Oregon's Hayward Field. Two-time Olympic and two-time world champion, Sandra Perkovic of Croatia, took second with a throw of 65.50m/214'11", and Kristin Pudenz of Germany took third with a throw of 62.58m/205'4". In the men's discus, the NYAC's Joe Kovacs, two-time Olympic silver medalist and two-time world champion, took second in the men's shot put with a throw of 22.49m/73'9 ½". Ryan Crouser, two-time Olympic champion and current world record-holder (23.37m/76'8 1/4"), won with a world-leading throw of 23.02m/75'6 ¼". Tomas Walsh of New Zealand took third with a throw of 21.96m/72'3/4". For complete results from Eugene, click here. Tuesday, May 31st; Ostrava, Czech Republic - The NYAC's Joe Kovacs won the men's shot put competition at the Ostrava Golden Spike, a World Athletics Continental Tour Gold meeting, with a throw of 22.25m/73'.
