# Track and Field: McFadden Fifth at Berlin Marathon

Sunday, September 24th; Berlin, Germany - The NYAC's Tatyana McFadden, 20-time Paralympic medalist and 20-time world championships medalist, finished fifth overall in the women's wheelchair race, in a time of 1:39:37, at the Berlin Marathon. Switzerland's Catherine Debrunner won the race in 1:34:16. Eden Rainbow Cooper (GBR) took second in 1:34:17, Manuela Schar (SUI) was

third, also in 1:34:17, and Susannah Scaroni (USA) was fourth in 1:34:31. Click here for full results for Berlin. Looking ahead to November, Tatyana will contest the NYC Marathon on Sunday, November 5th with hopes of qualifying for the 2024 Paris Paralympic Games, which will be hosted in the French capital from August 28th to September 8th, 2024. 

## Triathlon - NYAC Triathletes at the World Series Final

Saturday, September 23rd - Sunday, September 24th; Pontevedra, Spain - Kirsten Kasper and Matt McElroy were the top NYAC female and male finishers, respectively, at the World Triathlon Championship Series Final last weekend. Kirsten finished 15th in 1:55:17, narrowly defeating fellow NYAC and USA teammate Taylor Spivey, who crossed the line for 16th place in 1:55:19. Katie Zaferes was not far behind, finishing in 1:55:46 to claim 19th place. Great Britain's Beth Potter won the race in 1:53:19. On the men's side, Matt McElroy took 16th with a finish of 1:43:48, and Morgan Pearson took 55th in 1:48:04. France's Dorian Coninx won in 1:42:22. Click here for full results from Pontevedra.
