



## Knibb Retains IRONMAN 70.3 Oceanside Title




Saturday, April 6th; Oceanside, CA - Last weekend, the NYAC's Taylor Knibb reclaimed her IRONMAN 70.3 Oceanside title becoming the back-to-back champion of the grueling race which consisted of a 1.2-mile swim, followed by a 56-mile bike, and concluding with a 13.1-mile run. Nearly 11 minutes behind Taylor, Great Britain's Emma Pallant-Browne took second in 4:20:49, and Canada's Paula Findlay took third in 4:21:48. Taylor's 2:18 bike split equaled Daniella Ryf's 2019 course record and was over nine minutes faster than her competitors. With this performance, Taylor has secured her spot for the IRONMAN 70.3 World Championships which will be held in New Zealand in December. Looking ahead to the summer, Taylor, and fellow NYAC teammate Morgan Pearson, will contest the triathlon at the Paris 2024 Games. Maddie Musselman and Tara Prentice racked up four goals each, and goalie Amanda Longan recorded 13 saves. The women will return to the pool on Saturday, April 13th, for the thrid and final match at the Woollett Aquatics Center in Irvine, CA, with a 12pm PT start time. Thursday, April 4th - Sunday, April 7th; Sarasota, FL - NYAC rowers Sam Melvin (men's lightweight double, 6:48.50), Liam Galloway (men's quad, 6:04.40), and Teal Cohen (women's quad, 6:43.74) are one step closer to Paris 2024 after winning their respective events at the 2024 US Olympic and Paralympic Team Trials last week. As a result of their wins, Sam, Liam, and Teal will now join NYAC teammate Chris Carlson (men's eight) at the Final Olympic Qualifier in Lucerne, Switzerland in May - the last opportunity to qualify and be selected for the Paris Games. Already, the following nine NYAC rowers have been selected for Paris: Women's Eight - Charlotte Buck, Claire Collins, Kelsey Reelick, Maddie Wanamaker, Meghan Musnicki, Olivia Coffey, Regina Salmons; Men's Four - Nick Mead; Women's Lightweight Double Sculls - Molly Reckford. Also at the Trials, in the women's pair, Erin Reelick took third, Alina Hagstrom fourth, and Tracy Eisser and Megan Kalmoe, 6th. Additionally, Eliot Putnam took sixth in the men's single (7:39.47).
