# NYAC Swimmers Victorious in Westmont and Stockholm

Wednesday, April 12th – Saturday, April 15th; Westmont, IL – At the TYR Pro Swim Series Westmont, the NYAC's Hunter Armstrong, Tokyo 2020 gold medalist in the 4x100m medley relay, secured a hat trick, winning three separate events: the 100m freestyle (48.79 seconds), the 100m backstroke (52.59 seconds) and the 50m backstroke (24.30 seconds). The NYAC's **Ryan Held** took third in the 50m backstroke in 25.25 and fifth in the 100m freestyle in 49.09. Held also contested B Final in the 50m freestyle and the 50m butterfly, finishing first and fourth, respectively. Click here for full results. • **Thursday, April 13th – Sunday, April 16th; Stockholm, Sweden** – At the <u>Stockholm Open</u>, the NYAC's **Paige Madden** and **Catie DeLoof** secured three wins collectively. Madden, Tokyo 2020 silver medalist in the 4x200m freestyle relay, won both the 200m freestyle and the 400m freestyle. In the 200m freestyle, Paige touched the wall in 1:58.60, and a 4:10.75 clocking

secured the 400m freestyle win, while DeLoof, a Tokyo 2020 bronze medalist in the 4x100m freestyle relay, won the 100m backstroke, and placed second in the 50m freestyle. Catie and Paige also contested the 100m freestyle, with DeLoof finishing tied for third, and Madden placing eighth. Click here for full results.

## Triathlon - Zaferes Claims Title in St. Peters



Saturday, April 15th; St. Peters, MO – Tokyo 2020 Olympic

bronze medalist Katie Zaferes secured victory at the 2023 Ameri-

cas Triathlon Cup St. Peters, MO last weekend. The NYAC woman completed the course, which consisted of a 750m swim, a 20K bike, and a 5.11K run, in a time of 1:00.08, also logging the fastest swim (9:46) and bike (31:35) of the day. Her run time was 17:28. Fellow American Gwen Jorgensen placed second in 1:00.58, and Amelie Kretz of Canada finished third in 1:01.31. Click here for full results.

# Track and Field - Latest Action in FL, NJ, and CA

Friday, April 14th – Saturday, April 15th; Gainesville, FL – The NYAC's Will Claye, a two-time world indoor champion (2012, 2018), won the triple jump at the <u>Tom Jones Memorial</u> meet with a mark of 16.9m/55-5 ½. Two-time Olympic champion and four-time world champion, Christian Tay-

lor, returning from a lengthy bout of injury, placed second with 16.89m/55-5, and Donald Scott took third with 16.60m/53-10 ½. Click here for full results. • Friday, April 14th – Saturday, April 15th; Princeton, NJ – Two-time Olympian (2016, 2020) Rudy Winkler won the hammer throw at the Larry Ellis Invitational with an American season-leading mark of 77.87/255-5. Tyler Williams took second with 74.29m/243-8, and Ashraf Elseify of Qatar took third with 72.19m/236-10. Click here for full results. • Thursday, April 13th – Saturday, April 15th; Mount SAC Relays, Walnut, CA – The NYAC's Miranda Melville won the women's 20K race walk with a finishing time of 1:37:45.8, an American season-leading time. Arch rival, Maria Michta-Coffey, took second with 1:38:23.2, and Stephanie Casey took third in 1:41:09.3. In the men's 20K race walk, the NYAC's Emmanuel Corvera placed fifth in 1:34:01.4; Ever Palma of Mexico won the event in 1:23:00.6. Also at Mt. SAC, the NYAC's Michael Shuey took seventh in the javelin with a mark of 72.38m/237-5. Click here for full results.
