Brooke Andersen Sets Hammer Throw Personal Best

Thursday, April 20th - Saturday, April 22nd; Charlottesville, VA - The NYAC's Brooke Andersen, 2022 hammer throw world champion, won the hammer throw at the Virginia Invitational with a personal best, meet record, facility record, and world-leading mark of 79.80m/261-10. Nayoka Clunis of Jamaica took second with a personal best of 70.68m/231-11, and Jamaican teammate Erica Belvit took third with a personal best of 69.51m/228-0. Brooke's 79.80m mark is the third longest hammer throw mark in history, behind only Anita Wlodarczyk of Poland's 82.98m mark and the NYAC's own DeAnna Price's 80.31m mark. Click here for results from Virginia. • Thursday, April 27th; Des Moines, IA – A week after setting her personal best in the hammer throw at the Virginia Invitational, the NYAC's Brooke Andersen won her second consecutive competition, this time at the Drake Relays, with a mark of 78.69m/258-2, breaking the meet and facility records. Joining Brooke on the podium was the NYAC's Janeah Stewart, who took third with a throw of 71.60m/234-11. In the men's hammer throw, Rudy Winkler of the NYAC was the winner with a throw of 76.70m/251-8. The Central Park Track Club won with an overall finish of 1:37:17, and the Brooklyn Track Club took second in 1:39:35. Ryan Kutch of Central Park Track Club won the race in 19:07. The NYAC's top finisher, John Flannery, took seventh in 19:26. Other NYAC finishers include John Bleday (10th, 19:39), Will Shafer (12th, 19:51), Michael Cassidy (31st, 20:54) and Christopher

Winners of the races in Chula Vista will advance a step closer to representing the USA at the 2023 World Championships in Belgrade, Serbia from September 3rd to 10th. Thus far, the NYAC's Eliot Putnam won the men's single time trial in 6:35.05, and teammate Greg Davis finished seventh in 7:04.30. Putnam will contest Semifinal 1 and Davis, Semifinal 3, on Thursday, April 27th. Tracey Eisser and Meghan Kalmoe took fifth in the women's double time trial in 6:49.77 and will advance to the A Final on Friday, April 28th. In the women's pair time trial, the NYAC's **Meghan** Musnicki, with Alie Rusher, won in 6:55.39. The NYAC's Claire Collins, with Molly Bruggeman, took second in 6:56.13, and the NYAC's Alia Hagstrom, with Regina Salmons, took fourth in 7:00.73. These boats will contest the A Final on Friday.
