



Allman Opens Season with World Discus Lead



Wednesday, March 27th - Saturday, March 30th; Austin, TX - The NYAC's Valarie Allman, Tokyo 2020 Olympic discus champion, opened her season with a world-leading and meet record mark of 67.98m/223-0 to claim the discus title at the Clyde Littlefield Texas Relays in Austin, TX. Allman achieved the winning mark on her fourth throw of the competition. Jayden Ulrich, a junior from the University of Louisville, took second with 60.16m/197-4, and Michaelle Valentin of Florida International University was third with 58.32m/191-4. Judo - Laborde Gets Closer to Olympic Selection in Antalya

Friday, March 29th - Sunday, March 31st; Antalya, Turkey - Maria Laborde (-48kg) was the top NYAC finisher at the Antalya Grand Slam, advancing as far as the repechage before losing to Brazil's Natasha Ferreira by ippon (full point, instant win). After a bye into the round of 32, Laborde threw two-time Grand Slam medalist Katharina Tanzer (AUT) with a drop seoi nage (dropping shoulder throw) for a waza-ari (half-point) score. Laborde defeated two-time Senior Pan American champion Mary Dee Vargas Ley (CHI), in the round of 16, throwing Ley with a drop seoi nage midway through the match for a waza-ari and holding the Chilean scoreless for the remainder of the bout. Laborde lost her next two matches on penalties, however, falling to 2022 Senior World Championships bronze medalist Abiba Abuzhakynova (KAZ) in the guarter-finals and to the aforementioned Ferreira, the 2023 Senior Pan Am-Oceania Championships bronze medalist, in the repechage. Laborde is a 2014 World Championships bronze medalist and a bronze medalist from last year's Pan Am Games in Santiago, Chile. With her 2-2 result in Antalya, she is expected to move into the top 10 on the filtered Olympic Ranking List, with the top 17 qualifying for the Games. Also in Antalya, Angelica Delgado (-52kg) continued her bid to make a third Olympic team, placing in the top 16 with a 2-1 record. Ari Berliner (-66kg) advanced as far as the Round of 32, and Nate Keeve (-100kg) and Hannah Martin (-63kg) to the Round of 64. Click here for full results from Antalya.

Triathlon - Luis Takes Second in Lievin

Saturday, March 30th; Lievin, France - Tokyo 2020 Olympic bronze medalist (Mixed Relay) Vincent Luis finished second in the World Triathlon Indoor Cup Lievin, a unique super sprint indoor race consisting of heats, repechages, semi-finals, and B and A finals with the following format: 150m swim, 3K bike, 1K run. Luis claimed second place in the A final in 9:25, clocking 1:40 for the swim, 4:29 for the bike, and 2:41 for the run. Vetle Bergsvik Thorn of Norway won the race in 9:24. The race took place at an indoor facility which housed a 25m pool built in the infield of a track, the latter being utilized for biking (outer lanes) and running (inner lanes).
