Track and Field: Nick Christie wins US 5K Race Walk Title

Track and Field: Back-to-Back Wins for Nick Christie



Over the past two weekends, the NYAC's **Nick Christie** secured race walk wins in two races, the <u>USATF National Championship 5K Race Walk</u> on **Sunday**, **September 24th in Whiting, NJ**, and the <u>Marathon Relay Race Walk</u> in **Hauppauge, NY on Sunday, October 1st**. With the 5K victory, Christie added to a sterling season which has brought him US titles at 3000m (indoors), 5K, 20K and 35K. Legendary track writer and 1956 race walk Olympian, Elliott Denman, wrote of the race, "Californian Christie, now representing the New York Athletic Club, raced to the men's 5K title over principal domestic rival Dan Nehnevaj of the Raleigh Walkers. In this 11 am start event, Christie shook off Nehnevaj's early challenge and completed his four-lap assignment in 20 minutes flat. Nehnevaj crossed the line in 20:45. Christie's four laps: 4:45. 4:59, 5:07 and 5:09. Nehnevaj's four: 4:47, 5:16, 5:25, 5:17." The following weekend, on Sunday, October 1st, Christie teamed with two-time Olympian Maria Michta-Coffey to claim the Marathon Relay victory in a time of 3:18:40. Taking second place, again, was Dan Nehnevaj who teamed with Tokyo Olympian Robyn Stevens to record a time of 3:24:15. This race is particularly significant

as the Marathon Race Walk Mixed Relay is a new Olympic event, making its debut in Paris next year. Teams of one man and one woman will cover the marathon distance in four legs, with each walker completing two legs of approximately 10K each, alternating male, female, male, female.
