Track and Field - NYAC Race Walkers Set US Record

Sunday, January 21st; Santee, CA - At the USATF Marathon Race Walk Mixed Relay Championships, the NYAC's Nick Christie and Miranda Melville set an American record of 3:13:27 for the mixed marathon relay, a new race format unveiled in 2023. The format begins with a 12.195K walk by the male team member, then a 10K walk by the female. To conclude, the male and female each walk 10K. With this result, Christie and Melville qualified for the 2024 World Race Walking Championships, which will take place in Antalya, Turkey in April. That event will determine the 22 teams that will contest this inaugural event at the Paris Olympic Games. Notably in Santee, the NYAC's Emmanuel Corvera and his wife, Celine Lope, placed second in Santee and also gualified for the World Championships. Click here for full results from Santee.

Triathlon - Pearson Narrowly Misses Podium at National XC Championships

Saturday, January 20th; Richmond, VA - NYAC triathlete Morgan Pearson has already been selected for the US team for the Paris Olympic Games. But on January 20th, he turned his attention to his former sport, distance running, by taking part in the national championship in Richmond, VA. Proving that he remains a force to be reckoned with in this medium, Pearson placed a superb fourth over the 10K course, covering the distance in 29:15.5 and missing the podium by just three seconds. In his wake were some of the finest distance runners in the country, many of whom are eyeing

places on the track team for the Olympic Games. Pearson's finish in Virginia qualified him for the team that will contest the World Cross Country Championships in Serbia in March; however, he has chosen to eschew that event in order to focus on his primary sport and preparations for the Games. Notably, at the Tokyo Olympic Games, Pearson claimed a silver medal in the mixed triathlon relay. Commenting on Instagram of his US cross country championship outing, Pearson observed that it was a way, "...to keep me motivated through December and January....I love to test myself against some of the best runners in the country."
