





Rowing - Musnicki Qualifies for World Championships

Friday, June 16th - Sunday, June 18th; Varese, Italy – The American women's four, with the NYAC's Claire Collins, Maddie Wanamaker and Kelsey Reelick, and the American women's pair, with the NYAC's Meghan Musnicki, secured gold and silver medals, respectively, at the World Rowing Cup II. Musnicki, thus, secured her place, should she opt to take it, on the US team for the World Rowing Championships taking place in Belgrade, Serbia in September. The final composition of the women's four remains at the discretion of the selection committee. Writing on the Row2K web site, John FX Flynn, reported: "The women's four took gold ahead of Britain and Australia, setting a new World Cup best time of 6:17.55 just a bit more than two seconds clear of the British. The crew featured the top women's pair from the 2022 US squad--Tokyo Olympians Claire Collins and Madeleine Wanamaker--who won a bronze at last year's World Championships, along with two boatmates from the 2022 Worlds Eight they doubled into: Kelsey Reelick and Molly Bruggeman, who was a world champ in the four in 2018. "The race was very fun and exciting today," said Collins, who stroked the crew. "We were practicing sticking to our race plan and staying in our boat this weekend, and I think we learned and executed better and better each race." On the women's pair,

Flynn reported, "The two-boat battle between the Australian winners and the USA's Musnicki and Rusher in the second 500 strung out the field, and the medals were settled a bit earlier in this race. Spain took the bronze, just edging USA2, Jess Thoennes and Charlotte Buck, off the podium. Britain and Germany took fifth and sixth. The silver qualifies the Musnicki and Rusher pair for Worlds, which means that two-time Olympic champion (and three time Olympian) Musnicki will be prolonging the not-quite-retirement she discussed with row2k after the Winter Speed Order for a few more months." Also in Varese, the NYAC's **Nick Mead**, with his US teammates, secured a bronze medal in the men's four. Click here for full results from Varese.

Fencing - Holmes Secures Pan Am Championships Bronze

Wednesday, June 14th – Wednesday, June 21st; Lima, Peru – The 2023 Pan American Championships kicked off in Lima, with Kat Holmes competing in the women's epée. Holmes, a member of the 2018 US world championship-winning epée team, earned a bronze medal in the individual competition, tying with Brazil's Nathalie Moellhausen, and a gold medal in the team competition. The NYAC's Mitchell Saron took fifth in the individual sabre, and Stephen Ewart and Dylan Nollner placed eighth and 13th, respectively, in the individual men's epee. Track and Field - Price Wins Hammer Throw at Iron Wood

Thursday, June 15th and Saturday, June 17th; Rathdrum, ID - The NYAC's Deanna Price won the women's hammer throw with a mark of 77.25m/253-05 at the Iron Wood Throws Classic. Rachel Tanczos took second with 242-4, and Erin Reese placed third with 237-9. Also at Iron Wood, the NYAC's Daniel Haugh finished fifth in

the men's hammer throw with a mark of 74.69m/245-00, while **Michael Shuey** was fourth in the men's javelin with a mark of 71.95m/236-0. **Click here** for full results from Rathdrum. • **Wednesday, June 21st, Guelph, Ontario, Canada -** At Ontario's <u>Royal City Inferno Track and Field Festival</u>, the NYAC's **Mikey Brannigan** was denied victory in the open 1500m, placing second to Bison Athletic Club's Justin Kroeker by less than half a second (3:50.80 to the winner's 3:50.35). Cycling - Knibb Takes to the Bike

Thursday, June 22nd, Knoxville, TN - Best known as one of the top triathletes in the world, it should be no surprise that NYAC Athlete of the Year, **Taylor Knibb**, also excels on the bike. At yesterday's US Pro Time Trial Championship in Tennessee, Knibb faced a top class field, including two-time Olympic medalist Chloe Dygert, ultimately placing a superb fourth in a time of 31:41.22 for the 23.2K road course.
