Track and Field - NYAC Athletes Dominate in Europe

Friday, June 2nd; Florence, Italy – The NYAC's Valarie Allman, Tokyo 2020 Olympic discus champion and 2022 world bronze discus medalist, won the discus competition at the <u>Diamond League Golden Gala</u> with a mark of 65.96m/216-5. Bin Feng of China, 2022 world discus champion, took second with 65.91m/216-3, and Shanice Craft of Germany took third with 64.47m/211-6. Click here to watch Valarie's winning throw. Also in Florence, the NYAC's **Joe Kovacs**, two-time shot put world champion (2015, 2019) and two-time shot put Olympic silver medalist (2016, 2020), took fourth in the shot put with a mark of 21.55m/70-8 1/2. Leonardo Fabbri of Italy won with a season's best of 21.73m/71-3 1/2, Tom Walsh of New Zealand took second with 21.69m/71-2, and Tomas Stanek of the Czech Republic took third with 21.64m/71-0. Click here for full results from Florence. • Tuesday, June 6th; Bydgoszcz, Poland – The NYAC's Brooke Andersen and Rudy Winkler won the women's and men's hammer throw competitions, respectively, at the <u>Irena Szewinska Memorial</u>. Brooke secured her win with a throw of 78.79m/258-6, edging out second place finisher Camryn Rogers of Canada (77.62m/254-8) and fellow American Janee Kassanavoid (71.92m/235-11). On the men's side, Rudy won with a mark of 79.70m/261-6. Wojciech Nowicki of Poland took second with 79.52m/260-11, and Ethan Katzberg of Canada took third with 76.83m/252-0. Also in Bydogszcz, the NYAC's Chris Nilsen won the pole vault with a season's best mark of 5.92m/19-5. Poland's Piotr Lisek took second with 5.82m/19-1, and the Phillipines' Ernest Obiena took third with 5.72m/18-9 1/4. Click here for full results from Poland.



Judo - Laborde Finishes Seventh in Dushanbe

Friday, June 2nd – Sunday, June 4th; Dushanbe, Tajikistan – The NYAC's Maria Laborde finished seventh in the -48kg division at the <u>Dushanbe</u>

<u>Grand Prix</u>. Maria received a bye into the second round of competition, where she beat Swaita Swaita of India by waza ari. In the quarter-final, Maria was

defeated by Marusa Stangar of Slovenia by ippon, and by Narantsetseg Ganbaatar of Mongolia by waza ari. Marusa Stangar ultimately won the weight, and Narantsetseg Ganbaatar took the bronze medal. Also in Dushanbe, **Ari Berliner** (-66kg) defeated Daniel Kapelushnik of Israel in the first round by ippon but did not advance beyond the second round.

Dominic Rodriguez (-73kg) did not advance beyond his first round of competition. Click here for full results from Dushanbe.
