Yonezuka Claims Back-to-Back -73kg Titles in Tunis



Saturday, March 10th – Sunday, March 12th; Tunis, Tunisia – The NYAC's **Jack Yonezuka** claimed back-to-back -73kg titles, at the Tunis Junior African Cup and at the Tunis African Cup, last weekend. At the Tunis Junior African Cup, which was held on Friday, March 10th, Jack won all of his matches by ippon in 90 seconds or less. In the final, Jack took down Ammar Abohashim in 1:12 to secure the win. At the Tunis African Open, which was held from Saturday, March 11th – Sunday, March 12th, he defeated Thailand's Masayuki Terada by ippon in 6:24 in the final to secure his second -73kg title of the weekend. Prior to the final, Jack defeated Enzy Kom Teddy of Camaroon by ippon in the second round, Youcef Fardj of Algeria by ippon in the quarter-final, and Luke Davies of Great Britain by ippon in the semi-final. Antonio Candeiro of Angola secured the bronze medal after defeating Aden-Alexandre Houssein of Djibouti by ippon. Triathlon - Zaferes Finishes Second In Sarasota



Saturday, March 11th; Sarasota, FL – At the 2023 Americas Triathlon Cup Sarasota, the NYAC's **Katie Zaferes**, Tokyo 2020 individual silver and team bronze medalist, finished sec-

ond in the elite women's race in 56:07. Katie completed the 740m swim in 10:00, the 18.3K bike in 27:10, and the 5K run in 17:52. Amber Schlebusch of South Africa won the race in 55:55, and Mexico's Sofia Rodriguez Moreno finished third in 56:33. Click here for full results from Sarasota.

Friday, March 10th – Sunday, March 12th; Edinburgh, Scotland – At the Edinburgh International Swim Meet, the NYAC's Paige Madden finished second in the women's 14 and over 400m long course freestyle with a finish of 4:13.17. Loughborough University teammate Freya Colbert won in 4:09.04, and teammate Mia Slevin took third in 4:13.35. In the women's 14 and over 300m long course freestyle, Paige finished sixth in 2:00.37. Track and Field - Nilsen Takes Pole Vault Silver in Rouen

Saturday, March 11th; Rouen, France – At the Perche Elite Tour Rouen, a pole vault-centric track and field meet, the NYAC's **Christopher Nilsen**, Tokyo 2020 pole vault silver medalist, secured a silver medal in the men's elite pole vault with a mark of 5.92m/19'5". Fellow American Sam Kendricks, 2017 pole vault world champion, won, also with a mark of 5.92m/19'5", on account of having fewer attempts at 5.92m/19'5" than Nilsen. In pole vault, if athletes are tied, the athlete with the lowest number of jumps at the tied height is awarded the higher finishing place. France's Ethan Cormont took the bronze with a mark of 5.82m/19'1". **Click here** for full results from Rouen.
