




















NYAC Wrestlers Claim Six Pan-Am Championships Medals

Wednesday, February 21st - Saturday, February 24th; Acapulco, Mexico - NYAC wrestlers claimed six medals at the 2024 Pan-American Championships. Hayden Tuma was the NYAC's top finisher, claiming the Greco-Roman 63kg title after defeating Mexico's Hector Sanchez Zapata, 4-0. In addition to Tuma, Randon Miranda (GR 60kg), Mahmoud Sebie (GR 82kg), and Alan Vera (GR 97kg) each claimed silver medals in their respective weights, and Noah Wachsmuth (GR 72kg) and Adeline Gray (WFS 76kg) claimed bronze medals. Notably, Team USA claimed all three team titles – in men's freestyle, Greco-Roman, and women's freestyle. Rowing - Winter Speed Order Results, Olympic Selection Camp to Begin



Thursday, February 15th – Saturday, February 17th; Sarasota, FL – Regina Salmons was the top NYAC finisher at the <u>USRowing Winter Speed Order</u> in Nathan Benderson Park, Sarasota, FL, winning the women's pair in a time of 7:00.04. The women's pair was an NYAC affair, with the Club's own Claire Collins and Maddie Wanamaker taking second, Meghan Musnicki, third, Kelsey Reelick, fifth, Olivia Coffey, sixth, Charlotte Buck, eighth, and Tracy Eisser and Megan Kalmoe, ninth. In the women's single, Mary Reckford took third (7:34.12), and Teal Cohen (7:41.99), sixth. In the men's single, Michael Knippen took sixth (7:05.11) in the A final, and Sam Melvin (6:52.24) and Eliot Putnam (6:54.21) took first and second in the B final. Lastly, in the men's pair, Nick Mead finished third (6:27.14), and Chris Carlson finished ninth (6:31.88). Track and Field - McFadden Claims Gold in Dubai

Tuesday, February 13th - Thursday, February 15th; Dubai, Qatar - The NYAC's Paralympian Tatyana McFadden won three races - the T54 100m (15.03), T54 400m (51.72), and T54 800m (1:44.43) – at the <u>Dubai 2024 World Para Athletics Grand Prix/15th Fazza International Athletics Championships</u>.
