## The World's Finest Judokas Come to the NYAC

Saturday, March 25th; New York, NY – The 2023 New York Open Judo Championship was held in the NYAC City House gymnasium last Saturday, showcasing the world's finest judo talent and bringing together stars of the present and legends of the past, among them Kayla Harrison, Travis Stevens and Jimmy Pedro. The team format pitched the USA against France, Great Britain, Germany, Israel and Poland. The NYAC's stand-outs of the action-packed day included Maria Laborde, Jack Yonezuka, Dominic Rodriguez, Noran Elmahroukey and Alex Knauf. Laborde dominated at -48kg, winning three of her matches by ippon and securing a draw in her fourth. At -73kg, Yonezuka won both of his matches by ippon. Also in the -73kg category, Rodriguez won one match by ippon and drew in the other. At -57kg, Elmahroukey won one match and lost another, while Knauf showed his talent at -90kg, winning against Gurevitch Guy of Israel, a victory that secured the US team's spot in the final. There, the Americans faced France in a closely-matched battle. Though the USA won its first two matches by ippon, the French won the following four rounds by ippon, thus securing the team title. Watch for a full report in the May edition of *The Winged Foot* magazine. In other NYAC judo news, Ari Berliner (-66kg) and Hannah Martin (-63kg) each

contested the **Tbilisi Grand Slam**, which was held in **Tbilisi, Georgia from Friday, March 24th to Sunday, March 26th**. Ari Berliner lost to Orlando Polanco of Cuba by ippon in the first round and did not advance to the second round. After receiving a bye into the second round, Hannah Martin beat Kiyomi Wantabe of the Philippines by ippon and advanced to the third round, where she was defeated by Lucy Renshall of Great Britain by ippon in 37 seconds.
