



Nilsen Fourth at World Indoor Championships

Friday, March 1st - Sunday, March 3rd; Glasgow, Scotland – The NYAC's **Chris Nilsen**, Tokyo 2020 silver medalist in pole vault, took fourth in the pole vault at the [2024 World Athletics Indoor Championships](#) with a mark of 5.75m. Sweden's Armand Duplantis won the event with a world-leading mark of 6.05m, American Sam Kendricks took second with 5.90m, and Greece's Emmanouil Karalis took third with a season's best mark of 5.85m. Though Nilsen did not make the podium in Glasgow, he is currently ranked first in the USA and third in the world by World Athletics, behind only the aforementioned Armand Duplantis and the Philippines' Ernest John Obiena. Also in Glasgow, the NYAC's Harrison Williams was set to contest the heptathlon but unfortunately rolled his ankle in the 60m and was unable to complete the other disciplines.
