## NYAC Elite Athletes Honored at 2024 All Sports Dinner

**Monday, November 18th; New York, NY** - Last Monday was a gala occasion at the New York Athletic Club, as the NYAC's Olympians, Paralympians, world champions, national champions and many more were honored at the annual [All Sports Dinner](#). The All Sports Dinner is an NYAC tradition dating back to 1932 and has been frequented by innumerable legends in the world of Olympic sport, from Ray Ewry to Al Oerter. With NBC's Bruce Beck serving as this year's Master of Ceremonies, three-time Olympic swimming medalist, Paige Madden speaking on behalf of her fellow athletes, and legendary hockey player Henrik Lundqvist serving as guest speaker, it was a memorable conclusion to an Olympic year in which NYAC athletes claimed 30 Olympic and six Paralympic medals. Among the Paris medalists in attendance were **Kate Douglass** (swimming), **Valarie Allman** (track and field), **Nick Mead** (rowing), **Tatyana McFadden** (para track and field), **Mikey Brannigan** (para track and field) and **Seth Rider** (triathlon), to name just a few. An additional highlight was a special tribute to legendary sports broadcaster and NYAC member, **Larry Rawson**, who served as the Dinner's MC for 36 years. In the world of Olympic sports, the NYAC All Sports Dinner is a celebration unlike any other.



## Triathlon - Knibb Claims T100 Triathlon World Title

**Saturday, November 16th – Sunday, November 17th; Dubai, UAE** – The NYAC's **Taylor Knibb**, dominated at the inaugural [T100 Triathlon World Championship Final](#), claiming the world title, the perfect conclusion to the series for Knibb, who won stops in San Francisco, Ibiza, and Las Vegas along the way. She completed the T100 format, consisting of a 2000m swim, 78K bike, and 18K run, in 3:29:17, recording the following splits – 26:36 for the swim, 1:54:18 for the bike, and 1:06:26 for the run. Notably, her bike was the fastest of her competitors by nearly two minutes. Switzerland's Julie Derron took second in 3:31:08, and Australia's Ashleigh Gentle took third in 3:31:42. Also in Dubai, the NYAC's **Taylor Spivey** took eighth in 3:36:23 with the second-fastest swim (26:34) and run (1:04:56) of the day. [Click here](#) for full results from Dubai.

## Wrestling - Golston Prevails at Bill Farrell Tournament

**Friday, November 8th - Saturday, November 9th; New York, NY** - The NYAC's **Erin Golston** was the club's top finisher at the legendary [Bill Farrell Memorial Tournament](#), winning her WFS 50kg weight class after defeating fellow American Emily King Shilson in the final, 9-3. **Jordan Wood** advanced as far as the FS 125kg final where he lost to fellow American Trent David Hillger, 13-10. **Jesse Porter** advanced as far as the GR 82kg semifinal, and **Ravaughn Perkins and Logan Savvy**, the FR 72kg and GR 67kg quarterfinals, respectively.
