IRONMAN Arizona - True Victorious, Kanute Secures Bronze

Sunday, November 20th, 2022; Tempe, AZ – The NYAC's **Sarah True** was victorious at the IRONMAN Arizona on Sunday with a finish of 8:42:38. Sarah completed the 3.8K swim in 53:49, the 180K bike in 4:47:14, and the marathon in 2:55:33. Fellow Americans Skye Moench and Danielle Lewis took second and third in 8:47:28 and 9:03:18, respectively. On the men's side, Joe Skipper of Great Britain won in 7:46:00, American Matt Hanson took second in 7:49:48, and the NYAC's **Ben Kanute** secured the bronze medal in 7:51:25 in his IRONMAN debut.
